THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (OLD CAITHNESS ROAD), HELMSDALE (ONE WAY), TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council propose to make the following Order entitled The Highland Council (Old Caithness Road), Helmsdale (One Way), Traffic Regulation Order 2022 in terms of Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and 2(2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended

When the Order comes into effect, no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto other than in the direction specified opposite to the said lengths of road in Column 2 of the said Schedule

Column I	Column 2
C1019 Old Caithness Road From a point 65 metres or thereby southeast of its junction with the U2432 Lillieshall Street to its junction with the A9 (Edinburgh to Scrabster) Trunk Road, a total length of 142 metres or thereby.	From West to East.

On Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays I 0am to I 2.30pm and on Thursdays I 0am to I 2noon and 3 to 5pm.
